Main Objects

- a) To relieve the needs of parents who are in need as a result having a child in a neonatal unit by in particular the provision of grants and such other support and assistance as shall be thought fit; and
- b) To promote and protect the good health of women and their babies through education and raising awareness of pregnancy-related issues, particularly pre-eclampsia, premature babies and neonatal death including the education of those working in neonatal units to enable them to better care for such women and their babies.

The following information is not part of the 2016-2017 Annual Report but worth mentioning.

Aims, Plans & Aspirations

Whilst we were in hospital, before we were inclined to set up a trust, we received donations from **Deal Tri Club** and **Pete Bailey**. A total of £635.00 were donated directly to the **East Kent Hospital Charity** in July/August 2015.

In October 2015 now trustee Howard James, embarked on a gruelling training program with the aim to complete to Solo English Channel Swims.

This encouraged us to also raise money for the **William Harvey Hospital** in Ashford. With our first project being charity single, Express Yourself. A short period before its release, we were advised to set up a registered charity to give people confidence that all money raised would go to the neonatal unit.

During the same time, we supported a Deal Tri Club, English Channel Relay Team and £2,462.50 were raised and donated directly to the East Kent Hospital Charity in August 2016.

In August 2016 we became an official UK registered charity.

The Alexa Trust ANNUAL RETURN 2016-2017 Fundraising Events Summary

Initially we did not focus on promotions or donations. Our first major internal fundraising campaign started May 2016 during Howard's first English Channel Solo Swim.

During the summer of 2016 we received a heartfelt gesture from 5 young ladies, who painted pebbles on Kingsdown beach. All throughout the summer they were selling these to tourist and locals alike and raised an outstanding amount of £80.00.

In September 2016, Express Yourself was released and although profits were low, it proved The Alexa Trust with much needed exposure and awareness.

In November 2016 Howard successfully finished his second Solo swim. The two swims raised a respectable amount of £1,709.66

As awareness were growing so did our momentum. In the same month, November 2016, two of our friends **Lisa Mabbs** and **Kate Forey** came up with a brilliant idea to host a fundraising event by selling pre-loved clothes. With the support of the community, friends and volunteers, we managed to raise a whopping amount of £428.04.

A further fundraising event was held by selling CDs/DVDs & Books online. We received many items and managed to raise £146.92

From January to March 2017 we focused on our plans for the year ahead. And negotiations for a world first English Channel Relay team were underway to take place in April 2017.

Planning went ahead to see if we could get open water swimmers to complete an English Channel Relay and in the process, raise funds for The Alexa Trust. The response was outstanding, and we managed to confirm two relays teams with 6 swimmers each. A total of £2,308.53 was raised.




