Although we saw a good amount of growth, in some ways it was a slow year for The Alexa Trust as personal commitment from trustees Howard & Esmari James became priority. And less time could be given to The Alexa Trust.

Our main achievement for the year was to fund the first donor milk hub in Kent in association with The Human Milk Foundation, we expect the hub to open early 2020. The Alexa Trust also launched a new project; The Parents Fuel Fund at the William Harvey Hospital in Kent. Staff at the Neonatal Unit welcomed the financial help this project would offer parents. The first couple of payments has been made.

We also had an increase in sponsorship for our English Channel Relay Apparel, therefor the trust had minimal expenditure from this.

As a charity we are fortunate to now many amazing people who never hesitate to help us reach our goals. During this financial year we received many online, cash and cheque donations. 


